As a Morton Golf Foundation Junior Golf Grant winner, please be aware that there are guidelines that must be followed:

1. Please realize that you are joining an elite group of Junior Golfers that represent not only the Morton Golf Foundation, but The First Tee of Greater Sacramento and The Greater Sacramento Community as well!
2. Grant winners are expected to keep all “grades” at an average or above level
3. Attendance, by your parent(s), at Parent Support and Coaching workshop is required.
4. As a Grant Winner and Ambassador you will be expected to represent The Morton Golf Foundation in the best possible light, to include:

-Presenting yourself with a friendly and happy demeanor at all times

-Always practice The First Tee Nine Core Values: Confidence, Courtesy, Honesty, Integrity, Judgment, Perseverance, Responsibility, Respect, Sportsmanship

-Dress appropriate to all occasion specifically as follows:

Ladies: Shorts/Skorts must be of modest length (minimum length of mid-thigh).

Shirts and tops need to be worn in a conservative manner.

Gentlemen: Shirts must be tucked in, belts worn, shorts/pants need to be worn at the waist, hat facing forward.

-Exhibit exceptional hygiene: hair combed and an appropriate length, clean shaven, bright smiles, hands clean.

-Be punctual to all events.

-Be helpful to those around you.

-Stand out among other because of your exceptional personality, attitude and appearance.
